# What Is AI Prompting?

Let's start with the basics. AI prompting is much simpler than it might sound. It simply means typing a request or question into a tool like ChatGPT, and receiving a helpful response—just like asking a smart assistant for help.

That's it! No coding or programming required. Just asking questions or giving directions in plain, everyday language that you already use.

## Client Communication

*"Can you help me write a welcome email for a new client who needs home modifications?"*

## Content Creation

*"Give me 5 blog post ideas about home safety for older adults with mobility challenges."*

## Information Processing

*"Summarize this article about fall prevention in three key points I can share with clients."*

If you can write an email or send a text message, you already have all the skills you need to write effective AI prompts!

# Think of It Like Talking to a Helpful Assistant

The easiest way to understand AI prompting is to imagine having a helpful assistant sitting right next to you, ready to assist whenever you need. You wouldn't use technical language with a human assistant, and you don't need to with AI either.

You might simply say: *"Hey, I need a checklist for fall-proofing a bathroom for my elderly client. Can you help me make one?"* That's exactly how you talk to AI tools – natural, simple, and straightforward.



## Natural Language

Use everyday words and phrases just as you would in conversation



## Straightforward Requests

No need for complex formatting or technical terminology



## Clear Direction

Just be specific about what you need help with



## Always Available

Get assistance whenever you need it, day or night

# Let's Look at a Few Prompt Examples

The key to getting helpful responses from AI is being clear about what you want. Let's compare some examples to see the difference between vague and effective prompts.

## Not-so-great prompt:

*"Write a blog post."*

This is too vague. You'll likely get something generic that doesn't match your needs or your audience. The AI has no guidance on topic, tone, length, or purpose.

## Much better prompt:

*"Act as a geriatric care manager. Write a friendly blog post for adult children who are helping their aging parents stay safe at home. The topic is grab bars in the bathroom. Make it easy to understand and encouraging."*

This gives clear direction about the audience (adult children), topic (bathroom grab bars), and tone (friendly, encouraging). The AI now has enough information to create something useful.

The difference is in the details. By providing context and specific requirements, you'll get results that are much more relevant and ready to use with minimal editing.

# Why Use AI Prompting as an Aging in Place Professional?

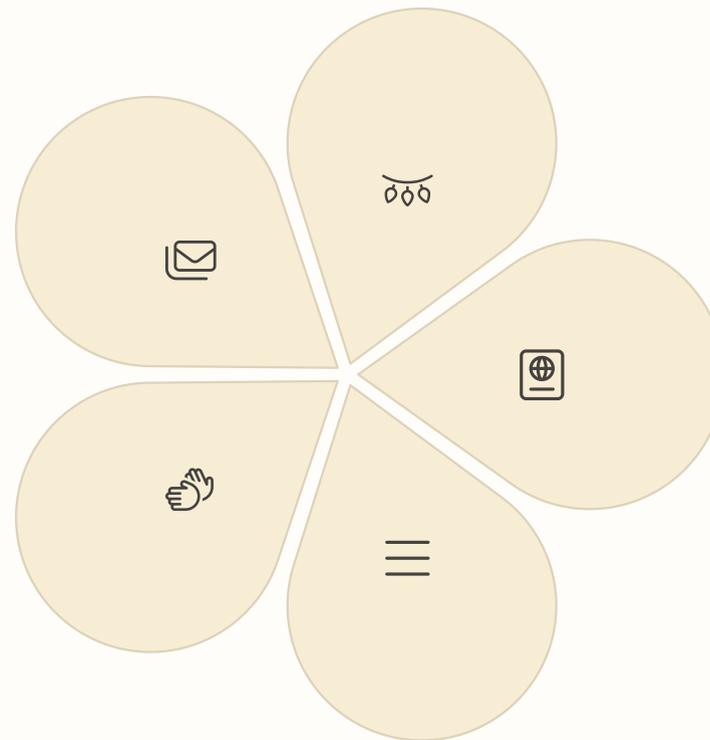
As an aging in place professional, you juggle multiple responsibilities daily. You're a problem-solver, communicator, small business owner, caregiver, and community advocate—often all at once. AI prompting can help lighten this load in numerous practical ways.

Save time writing emails, follow-ups, and information sheets

## Client Education

Translate complex concepts into easy-to-understand language



## Content Creation

Generate ideas when you're experiencing creative blocks

## Business Documents

Draft better proposals and service descriptions

## Organization

Create outlines, checklists, and structured plans

Remember, you don't need any special technical skills to leverage these benefits. If you can type a question, you can use AI to enhance your practice.

## Writing a Client Email

*"Write a short, warm email to a new client who just booked a home safety consultation. Let them know what to expect and how long the visit will take."*



## Brainstorming Ideas

*"Give me 5 topic ideas for a Facebook post about aging in place services."*



## Creating a Checklist

*"Make a checklist for home modifications that help a senior with limited mobility stay safe in the bathroom."*



Notice how you don't need to worry about special formatting or technical language. You can simply type as if you were talking to a colleague, using natural, conversational language to get helpful results in seconds.

# 4 Tips for Great Prompts

Creating effective prompts doesn't require technical expertise, just a bit of structure. These four simple tips will help you get consistently useful results from AI tools, saving you time and frustration.



## Be clear and specific

You can begin with something like *"You are a contractor who specializes in bathroom renovations."* Then state exactly what you want (write an email, make a checklist, give ideas)



## Include the audience

Specify who you're addressing (seniors, adult children, healthcare providers)



## Set the tone

Indicate the desired style (friendly, professional, compassionate)



## Specify the format

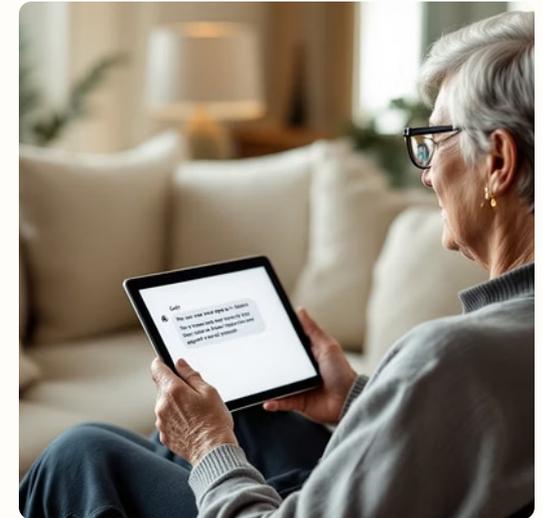
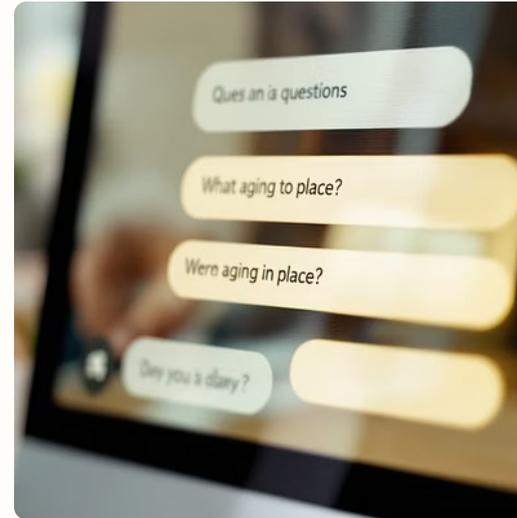
Request the output structure (list, email, paragraph, social media post)

# Common Concerns

### Will AI Replace Me?

No. AI is a support tool—not a replacement for your expertise, compassion, or human connection. It can help you work more efficiently, but the heart of your service remains uniquely human.

### Is It Safe For Client Info?

Avoid entering sensitive information like names, addresses, or medical history. Think of AI as a brainstorming partner—not a place to store or process confidential client records.

### Which Tool Should I Use?

For beginners, ChatGPT ([chat.openai.com](https://chat.openai.com)) offers a free version that's user-friendly. Microsoft's Copilot is another option if you already use Word or Edge browser.
